RE: Still River Subdivision and the Pewaukee School District

This letter is in response to your request that the Pewaukee School District issue a letter stating its current position on the open enrollment program as it pertains to the Still River Subdivision. The Still River Subdivision is located entirely within the City of Pewaukee, but is within the district boundaries of the School District of Waukesha. Still River lies right on the boundary between the School District of Waukesha and the Pewaukee School District.

The Pewaukee School District participates in the open enrollment program and anticipates continuing to participate in this program in the future. As a result, the residents of Still River Subdivision would have the option of applying for admission to the Pewaukee Schools through the open enrollment program as long as the District is actively participating by opening available seats and the program is still available. Actual admission to the Pewaukee Schools for an individual student would be based upon seat availability at the time of application, so enrollment in the Pewaukee Schools for Still River residents cannot be guaranteed.

Currently, a student that is already enrolled as a resident in the Pewaukee School District and moves into Still River with his/her family would be guaranteed continued admission through a tuition waiver process to complete the current school year and potentially the subsequent year depending on the date of move. The statutory provision allows students to attend as tuition waiver students until they have the opportunity to apply for open enrollment. In addition, it is our understanding that the bus company is currently providing bus service to some open enrollment students that live near Still River and outside of the Pewaukee School District. This transportation is provided contingent on the stop being located along a regular route and a space being available on the bus. If the bus company continues to provide this service, busing may be provided to Still River residents that attend Pewaukee Schools, however, there is no guarantee that this will occur.
